## Message from the Steering Committee...

On Monday, Dec. 12, the steering committee, finishing their responsibility, held a meeting with Murray & Mike from HMA Architects and Ryan from Breitbach Construction and presented the information gathered to the Parish and Finance Councils. It is now the responsibility of the Parish and Finance Councils to evaluate the options and assess the financial information (both construction costs and available insurance dollars) to move forward in making a decision. It is the councils desire to send out a mailer to each household within the parish to inform parishioners of the information presented.

We would also like to bring forth five points the bishop had made in a meeting a couple weeks ago that was also presented to the councils.

As you know, members of the Steering Committee and the trustees recently met with Bishop Kettler. We were all hoping he would listen, tap his staff on the floor and tell us what we should do and then tell us to follow him and he would lead our parish out of this modern day version of the desert. But, he didn't. He listened attentively and then told us we would have to make our own decision and that we should make it with faith and trust. He did, however, make a few very relevant points:

Take your time. Do it right and build for the next 100 years.

Be mindful of your youth and future generations. Give them an open church with modern technology so they will become engaged and stay engaged. A member of our committee asked Bishop Kettler about all the old, beautiful churches in Europe and the Bishop replied that they are all empty. And they are empty because people forgot to keep their youth engaged. This begs the questions: is it the building or is it what we do with and for our people that keep them engaged? And, can we keep people engaged in a church where a good number of the seats have a totally obstructed or semi-obstructed view of the table? Does this foster engagement and participation or does it promote simple attendance instead? Questions to ponder.

Be mindful of the disabled and handicapped and provide them with an easily accessible church. A point to consider: we live in an aging population. People in Stearns County live longer than any other county in the state. We do have an access issue with our church and, contrary to some, it is not good exercise to climb those steps into the church. Try telling that to an 85-year old with a bad heart or bad knees or hips who stands at the bottom and stares up with a look like they have to climb a mountain to get into church.

Socialize—give your parishioners a place to gather and share fellowship. Bishop Kettler told us he is trying very hard to get a fellowship hall built at the cathedral so they would not have to use their basement or lower level. He told us that if there is an after mass event in the basement they lose 50 percent of their attendees.

Be mindful of finances. He told us he does not like construction projects that include phasing because it increases the final costs.

Your continued prayers for the guidance of the Holy Spirit within our councils and community are greatly appreciated!
