● On Tuesday June 12, 2018, a delegation of Fr Marv, representatives of parish leadership, the parish architect (HMA) and liturgical design consultant (Ken Griesemer) will present the parish's design for a new worship space and related church facilities to the Diocesan Building Commission (DBC) seeking its approval to proceed with construction.

● Shortly after the approval and any recommendations from the DBC are received, HMA will begin drafting the construction documents.

● Approval of the design by the DBC, completion of the design incorporating any additional recommendations and the start of the preparation of construction documents are major milestones in this church-building process.

● The Parish Council is grateful for all of your prayers, work and support which have brought the achievement of these milestones within reach. We are building a church for the parishioners of St. Mary's. Thanks to each of you!

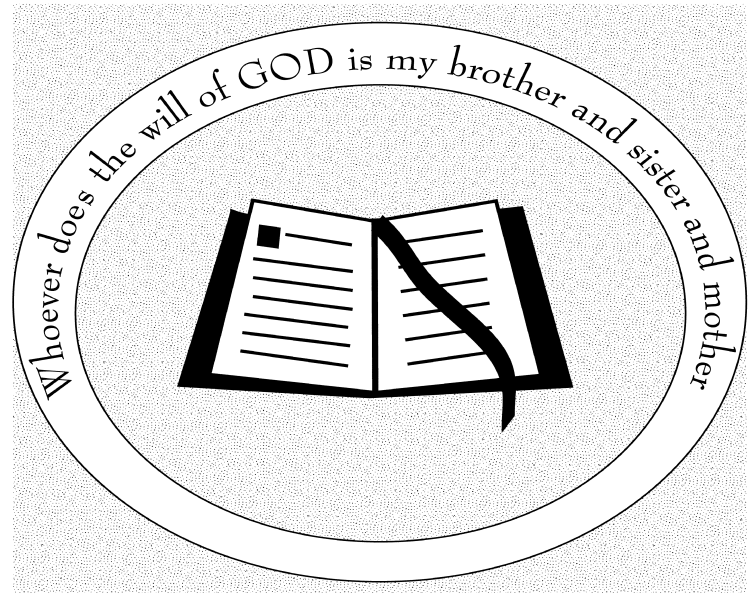

On Liturgy – Reconciliation

Today in Scripture we hear about both sin and forgiveness. The forgiveness of sins is celebrated in the sacrament of Reconciliation. Where is this sacrament celebrated? Most of us will recall in our minds images of "confessionals". Either stand-alone or built-in to the church, and usually ornate in exterior design, confessionals are prime examples of space that celebrates and signifies of a sacrament. What does a "modern confessional", often referred to today as a "reconciliation room", look like?

Reconciliation rooms are usually more spacious than the narrow "booths" of older confessionals to provide complete accessibility. Church documents and directives continue to influence design by requiring a screen, grille, or barrier to ensure anonymity for those who desire it, while also providing the option to confess face-to-face. The room is designed to be sound-proof, and a window to ensure visibility and safety for both the priest and the penitent is commonplace. Comfortable furniture and inviting décor might encourage a more open dialogue about both sin and forgiveness. How else might we lift up the graces of this sacrament in our reconciliation room design?

Beyond the reconciliation room, where else in our new worship space might people celebrate the Rite of Penance, particularly during communal Reconciliation services of Advent and Lent?
