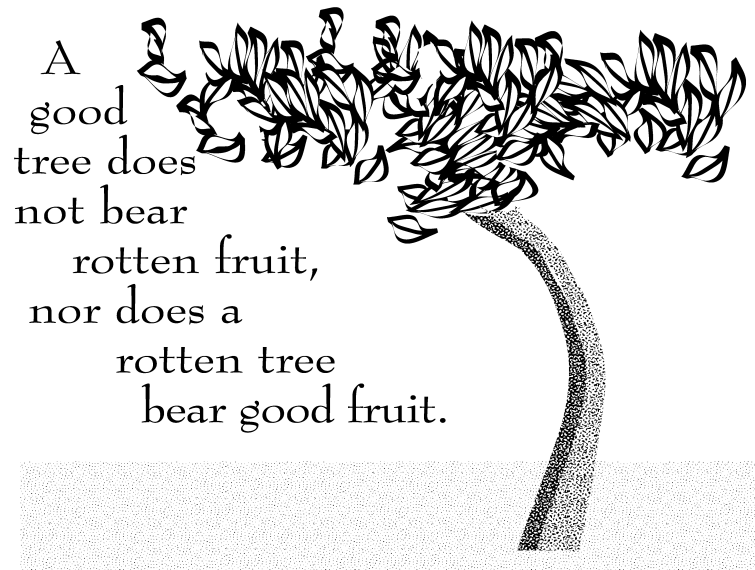

**On Liturgy – Inside the Church: Hospitality -- Chris Calderone**

The last liturgical ministry we will explore should actually be the one you encounter first when entering a church: the hospitality ministers. Many churches use the term “ushers” to describe those who fulfill traditional roles of finding seating for people, taking up and securing the collection, and distributing materials such as parish bulletins. However, being hospitable to all who enter the church doors is at the heart of this ministry, and this will be especially vital when our new church doors open. While the church building must be designed to support all of our parish's liturgical ministers, our hospitality ministers will be in the unique role of supporting the church building and all who gather in it.

With a modern building comes modern amenities. In addition to their traditional roles, hospitality ministers will know the locations and functions of restrooms, water fountains, baby changing tables, handicap entrances, hearing assistance devices, first aid kits, AEDs, information boards, and other features that serve to create a welcoming, functional, and hospitable environment. Our new church should also have a secure place for collections, as well as storage for collection baskets and other items needed by hospitality ministers. Finally, the ministry of hospitality calls for every sign, placard, building feature, parish publication, and parishioner to convey the same message: “You are welcome here”.

During Lent we will turn our focus back to the many aspects of our new church building.
