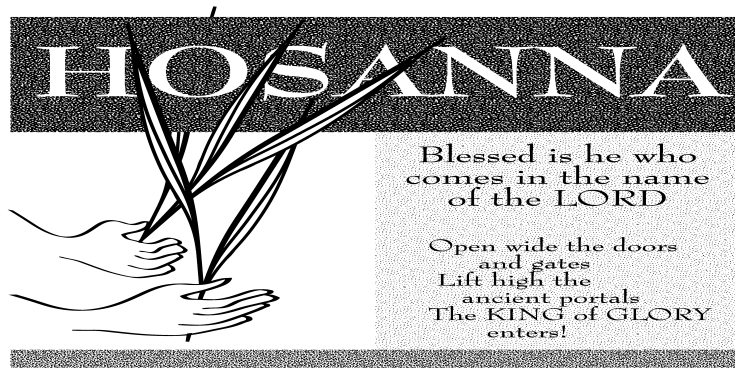

On Liturgy – Palm Sunday & Processions --Chris Calderone

After reviewing Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil,
 we find ourselves at Palm Sunday, or Passion Sunday, at the onset of
 Holy Week. At the beginning of this Mass, we commemorate Je-
 sus's entry into Jerusalem. Many parishes around the world recreate
 Jesus's procession into Jerusalem with festive processions into their
 churches from outside or from gathering spaces. Processions have an
 integral part in our liturgies: Masses, weddings, funerals, and other
 celebrations often begin with a procession to the sanctuary, and often
 end with a procession out of the church and into the world.

Processions do not need to be long in length or in numbers of peo-
 ple to be significant. Design elements of churches can highlight and
 signify processions in various ways. A gathering space might pro-
 vide sheltered indoor space for an assembly to gather before pro-
 cessing into the church itself. A church might be designed with ac-
 cessible and step-free aisles and paths from its doors to the Altar for
 universal participation. What draws us in as we process into our
 church? As Jesus processed into the splendor of Jerusalem, knowing
 he would sacrifice himself there, let us imagine how our new church
 might receive the magnificent processions that lead us to the Altar of
 God and out to the world.
