I hope this meeting helped everyone understand a bit more clearly that as pastor, I regard this church as your church and my intention is to incorporate into the restoration/construction process what you express as needed and/or desired. The Steering Committee has now narrowed the selection of companies to act as Construction Managers to four. Within the next week, they intend to narrow that number down to two. We will then be interviewing the two companies in an effort to choose the one company that will act as Construction Manager for the restoration/building process. The Steering Committee will then work with HMA Architects to incorporate your recommendations into a restoration/construction plan that will be presented to the Construction Manager for finalization.

As you can see, there is a considerable amount of process work yet to be completed. I realize that all of us would like to see this work begin immediately. However, this all takes time. So, please know this will require some patience.

I am grateful to the members of the Steering Committee for all the hours and special efforts they have made to get us to this point in the process. We are very blessed to have them as members of St. Mary's!

Again, thanks to all of you who are offering your input to this process - it is most appreciated. I believe that if we continue to listen to each other and work together we will end up with a worship space and a faith community that is beautiful, inspiring and Christ-centered. Looking forward to the day that our church will again become a place we call "Home!"
