


**Parish Council message**

- **This past weekend's presence in our parish by Liturgical Design Consultant Ken Griesemer was most beneficial for the Church of St Mary.** On Saturday, Mr Griesemer met in a marathon-long, but highly invigorating, session with the Design Team. The all-day event focused on the interior design of the main worship space, the blessed sacrament chapel which will be a significant part of the main worship space and contain the tabernacle, the gathering space – also called the narthex, and the Marian Chapel – formerly known as the daily mass chapel. The agenda topics for the day included eight major discussion topics and 34 subtopics. They ranged from statuary, tabernacle, artwork and church furnishings to the positioning of Eucharistic Ministers at Communion to facilitate an orderly flow. We discovered such things do not just happen, they are planned to flow smoothly. Following opening comments regarding the overall vision for arts and furnishings, a limited discussion, also led by Mr Griesemer, was held regarding exterior art and site design. It was an inspiring day for the participants and a good day for our parish's building project.
- The success of the Saturday design team event with Mr Griesemer was followed by a similarly highly successful event on Sunday afternoon during which Mr Griesemer led discussions as the members of our parish reflected on the role and importance of the Blessed Mother as patroness of our parish and how best to honor and enshrine her images in our multicultural parish. In addition to Mr Griesemer's presentation, six individuals representing various ages, cultures, experiences and backgrounds shared, to the delight and interest of the many attending, their unique and personal perspectives of Mary in their lives. It was a most satisfying, interesting and important Sunday afternoon and weekend for our parish.

**On Liturgy – Mary, Queen of Peace** --Chris Calderone  
 Last Sunday, I joined about 60 other members of our faith community in the school gym for a presentation led by Ken, our liturgical consultant. Expecting a discussion about Marian images, depictions, and artwork, I was surprised when Ken started with the theology of liturgical inculturation. We reviewed the balance of unity and diversity in the Church and how it impacts our liturgical celebrations, and then turned to "story-telling". It was in these stories that the role of Mary in the diverse lives of our parishioners emerged. Ken shared his personal experience attending a "Border Mass" on the US-Mexico border, during which those on either side of the border exchanged the Sign of Peace through the chain-link fence. Another parishioner spoke of our parish history, when in 1958 the bishop decided that "Mary would be the peace between the Irish and German parishes" as St. Patrick and St. Boniface parishes merged to create St. Mary's Parish. Another parishioner spoke of Mary's role in bringing peace to personal and family life. Still another spoke of Mary as a source of peace and unity amidst confusion and uncertainty in our new church project. Indeed, the "Queen of Peace" and patroness of our parish may continue to unite us and orient us towards Christ as we move forward with our new church project. The question remains open: how will we honor Mary, Mother of God, in our new church, for all she has done for this parish?
