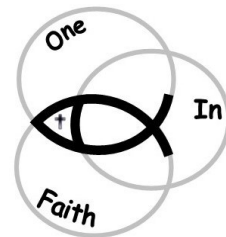

The project will include new flooring, upgraded restrooms, upgraded ceiling and lighting, addition of storage rooms, and an alternative heating system. The project is estimated at \$350,000. Private donations of \$250,000 have already been committed. The basement will be off limits once this project begins. This may cause some inconveniences but in the long run will be well worth it.
