#### One in Faith (4) Administrative Coordinator for Faith Formation

The One in Faith 4 cluster of parishes (St. Andrew's, St. John's, St. Michael's, and St. Mary's) is seeking a person to coordinate the administrative responsibilities for their joint faith formation program. This position averages 10 hours per week, but the amount of time per week will vary, depending on the time of year. Although significant computer work is required, the faith formation administrative coordinator is also responsible for initiating and maintaining good communication with our faith formation families. This person helps our parishes in the essential ministry of welcoming families and inviting them into deeper participation in the life of our parish communities.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:
