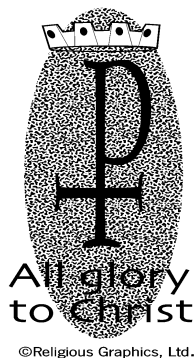

*A Message by Fr. Marv...*  
Good and Faithful People,

This past Tuesday evening, May 31, 2016, the parish leadership (Parish Trustees, Parish Council and Parish Finance Council) as well as George Traeger and Mel Roehrl met with Mark Greenwald and Chris O'Hagen of Catholic Mutual Insurance Group; Chaz Mello and Doug Dephillips of JS Held; and Murray Mack of HMA Architects. Mark Greenwald shared with us information regarding our insurance coverage and Chaz Mello and Doug Dephillips reported their ongoing efforts to arrive at cost estimates regarding the projects surrounding the restoration of St. Mary's Church. They believe they should be able to arrive at more solid numbers within four weeks. Murray Mack reported that he is continuing to develop drawings for the restoration process while continuing to check with the City of Melrose regarding building code requirements. Murray suggested that we form some type of Steering Committee to address the many questions that need to be answered as the restoration/construction process gets underway.

Following the meeting, discussion arose as to whether a Steering Committee would be helpful as this project moves forward. Rick Klaphake agreed to chair this committee. I will report who the members of this committee are once the membership is in place. The question was raised whether it would be possible for parishioners to view the inside of the church. Mark Greenwald and JS Held commented on the danger that continues to exist within the building due to falling plaster. As we talked further, we decided that opening the doors on the east end of the church would allow people to look inside without placing them in danger. When the needed security measures are in place, I will announce when the church would be available for viewing.

So, things are moving forward!!! We are planning another meeting with the above named people four weeks from now when more exact cost numbers should be available. In the meantime, Murray Mack will be meeting with the Parish Council to discuss further building code and construction questions. Also, the Steering Committee should be formed and begin to offer ideas and suggestions to the Parish Leadership for their consideration.

As Pastor, I know we are very blessed to have the people who are serving on our Council's and Committees. I am impressed with their commitment and their deep desire to do what is best for St. Mary's. A sincere "Thank You" to all of you who are serving so generously and faithfully!
