

On Liturgy – The Tabernacle

This past week our liturgical consultant, Ken Griesemer, gave two presentations on liturgical design. One focal point of these presentations was the tabernacle. The Blessed Sacrament, reserved in the tabernacle, is the focus of much private prayer and devotion, and rightfully so. The "reservation" of the Blessed Sacrament, however, stands in contrast to the "active presence" of Christ Jesus that we experience when we celebrate the Eucharist as an assembly. This shared liturgy focuses on both the sacrifice at the altar and the meal shared by the community. During Mass, our focus shifts away from the place of "reposition" and towards the active reception of Christ, in both Word and Sacrament. In this way, the tabernacle might be a focus for private prayer, while the altar remains a focus during communal worship. When I was trained as an altar server many years ago, I was taught to reverence the tabernacle outside of Mass, but to reverence the Altar during Mass. Perhaps some of you learned this protocol of reverence, as well. The design of our new church gives us an opportunity to further emphasize the difference between these two equally important forms of worship. A dedicated space for private prayer in front of the tabernacle can be just as meaningful as a dedicated space for celebrating the Mass together, especially if each is designed for its specific purpose. The theology around these concepts has great depth, and is worth more discussion. Feel free to message me, and talk to each other!
