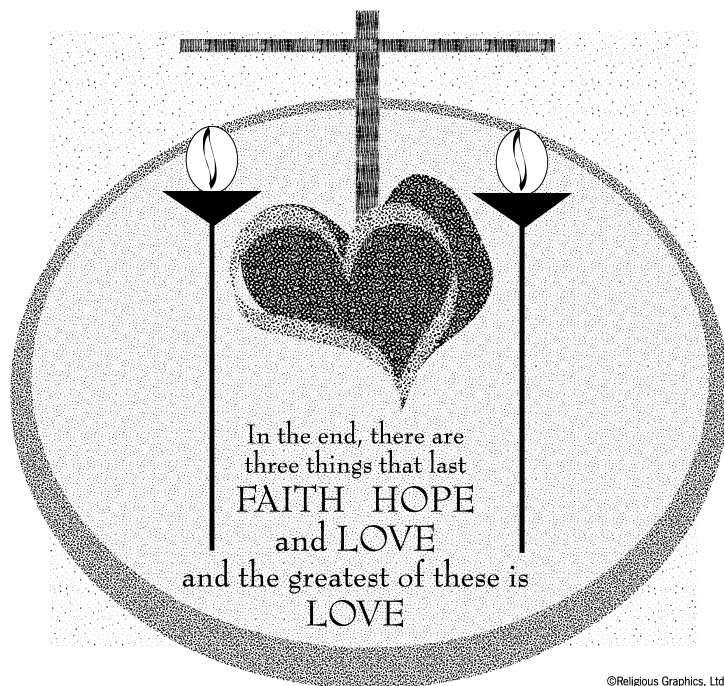

On Liturgy – Inside the Church: Living Word -- Chris Calderone

Today's Gospel begins right after Jesus proclaims prophetic Scripture to the synagogue. When we think of proclaiming the Word of God in church, our attention likely goes to the ambo. The ambo is indeed the place from which the Word is proclaimed to the assembly. Instead of focusing on the ambo itself, let's instead turn our attention to the ministry and the ministers. How might our new church support us – both lay ministers and clergy – in the ministry of proclaiming God's Word?

Our liturgical consultant has spent much time presenting to our parish the idea of an accessible ambo. Such an ambo's height can be adjusted to accommodate those in wheelchairs, children, taller adults, and all in between. When the Word is proclaimed, it should be heard clearly by all. This is where a quality acoustic environment, a state-of-the-art sound system, and hearing assistance devices for the hearing-impaired come into play. What is the Word proclaimed from? Thought should be given to the size and style of our parish's lectionary and/or Book of Gospels. Finally, our parish liturgies are celebrated in more than one language. Perhaps the new projector screens will allow for the reading of a translation in one language while the Word is proclaimed in another.

We also have generous ministers who bring the Word of God alive to our youngest parishioners during Children's Liturgy of the Word. Our new church can support this ministry by designating ample space apart from the main worship space for children to gather, learn, and pray together during the Liturgy of the Word. The Word of God will continue to come alive in our new church, through all who proclaim it!
