

Return to Mass: July 1 Marks End of Dispensation in Minnesota The bishops of the Minnesota Catholic Conference, including Bishop Kettler of the Diocese of St. Cloud, have announced that beginning the weekend of July 3-4, 2021, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be reinstated. They stated in their letter, "As the COVID-19 pandemic subsides, and public gathering restrictions and safety protocols are lifted, it is time to gather as the Body of Christ once again." Why is attending Mass in-person to important? "St. John Chrysostom reminds us, 'You cannot pray at home as at church, where there is a great multitude, where exclamations are cried out to God as from one great heart, and where there is something more: the union of minds, the accord of souls, the bond of charity, the prayers of the priests' (CCC 2179). Attending the in-person celebration of Sunday Mass and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist are vital to our lives as Catholic Christians. We were created for Communion. Whether you are returning to your home parish, or seeking a local parish on vacation, your participation in the Mass unites you with the Church - the Body of Christ. This communion transforms us as persons and enables us to make manifest the Kingdom of God in our world. The celebration of the Eucharist truly is the source and summit of our faith." Prior to the pandemic, persons were excused from the Mass obligation if certain circumstances existed. Dispensation is still allowed for persons falling within these circumstances.
