On Liturgy – Images and Artwork

In the year 2000, the Vatican declared that the Sunday after Easter would thereafter be known as "Divine Mercy Sunday". Perhaps you are familiar with the image associated with "Divine Mercy": Jesus with outstretched hand, red and white rays of light shining from his heart as symbols of blood and water flowing from his side on the cross. One often finds the words, "Jesus, I Trust In You" underneath this image. Devotion to the Divine Mercy of Jesus is practiced by many Catholics around the world.

As stated last week, Jesus comes to us in infinite ways. Artists have thus been inspired to depict Jesus in near-infinite ways over the centuries, along with Mary, Mother of God, and many of the saints. However, you might identify with one image of Jesus but not another. Likewise, a certain depiction of Mary might be near and dear to a person, parish, culture, or entire country, but may not mean as much to others. What images speak to your heart? Please consider coming to Ken Griesemer's workshops this week to learn more about artwork in churches, among other liturgical topics,

and to give input concerning our new church. Beyond this, share with each other the "holy artwork" that is most meaningful to you. How do you see Jesus? How does St. Mary's Parish see Mary?
