Because this will be a presentation regarding the entire St. Mary's Parish campus, a portion of it will include possible financing options and the needs of St. Mary's School.



On Liturgy - Holy Communion

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – perhaps known better as, "Corpus Christi" - was declared a feast day in the 13th century by Pope Urban IV, but the celebration of the Eucharist dates back, of course, to the Last Supper shared by Jesus and his apostles. This first Eucharist, and Corpus Christi, have given rise over the centuries to Eucharistic processions, which in turn gave rise to elaborate monstrances, which are now commonly used during Eucharistic Adoration. These devotional practices orient us to the greater sacrament of Holy Communion, and it is this sacrament which remains the primary focus of the Church and of most church

Despite the frequency with which we celebrate Holy Communion at Mass, the details that help a community celebrate this sacrament well should not be overlooked! "Communion" requires community, and a large, accessible worship space to gather the entire community together. We engage in our own "Eucharistic procession" when we come forward in spacious, well-planned aisles to receive Communion from Eucharistic Ministers who have adequate space to facilitate the gracious flow of the assembly in procession. Of course, the altar is of primary significance in this sacrament, and should stand as a "center of thanksgiving" for the Eucharist, visible by the whole gathered community. As much as we receive Holy Communion, every celebration of this sacrament should be a true celebration!
