Parish Council Message ...

Church Building Team (CBT) Update:

- The Construction Committee, the Audio Video Acoustic Committee, contractors and consultants continue to work on acoustic, lighting, security, entrance and fire suppression systems for our new church.
- The delivery of the steel for the above ground construction of Phase 1 (Worship Space, Gathering Space, Administration Space, Drive Up Canopy and Bell Tower) is expected soon. The steel will first be erected for the Administration Space.
- Underground utility work is beginning this week.

Forward in Faith Capital Campaign (FIFCC) Update:

- Pledges to date = \$1,907,477.72
- Gap to \$2,400,000 = \$492,522.28

Finance Council (FC) Update:

- The CBT and FC are continuously evaluating the construction budget and funds available. The best case scenario is that in reaching our FIFCC goal, we can build our Phase 1 (See above) as planned and presented.
- Now is the time to make or add to your pledge. We can close this gap!
